This medium-bodied wine is ripe with sweet black-cherry, raspberry and dark-chocolate aromas. A mineral layer on the palate and finish prevents the sweet fruit from running away (always a problem with zebras). It is a food-friendly wine that will fit in perfectly at your next barbecue. (DC)
